General Information

1. Show begins promptly at 8 a.m. The show arena is open for schooling from 7 - 7:45 a.m.
2. Lunging is **only** permitted in the covered round pen.
3. Awards to first place, ribbons 1st through 6th place with a Championship and Reserve in each division. A rider must show in at least 3 classes in the 1-4 divisions to be eligible for the Championship. Management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes if less than 2 entries.
4. Please Absolutely NO DOGS allowed on the show grounds at any time.
5. Show ring is 110' x 270' with GGT footing and the warmup ring is 75' x 150' with a sand base. A water/drag will happen after leadline.
6. All riders must wear ASTM-SEI certified headgear and appropriate attire while mounted.
7. Food and beverage will be available for sale on premises at the backyard cafe.
8. A **LIMITED** number of paddocks and overnight stabling may be available, first come first served. Please call or email show management to confirm.
9. Parking is limited. Please observe signage and only park trailers in the designated trailer parking to the right of the driveway as you enter.
10. Emailing entries is acceptable.

Description of Special Classes

The TVC Style of Riding Division will be run as a four phased Medal. Riders must complete each class in the division to be eligible for the Championship. Please let us know on your entry if you will be in the 2'9 or 3'3" height. If no choice is given we will run it at 2'9".

Class 17 will be a "Maclay Style" Equitation flat class and may include no stirrup work, counter canter, and swapping of horses. Tests are up to the judge's discretion.

Class 18 will be a "Big Eq" style course with tests built in and will be judged as an Equitation Medal. It may include a trot fence, a fence without irons, a halt, a counter canter fence and/or a hand gallop fence.

Class 19 will be judged as a working hunter class and may include a trot fence and a hand gallop fence.

Class 20 will be "first round jump off" jumper rounds.

Class 30- \$200 Mini Prix 1.10m Jumper Special. Table II 2A/B

\$200 CASH TO THE WINNER. No time first round.

Class 31 Jumper Pairs - fast and clean wins!

Rider 1 will ride in the .60m or .70m class and must designate at start of day which score will be used in the "pair" ride.

Rider 2 will ride in any class above the .80m and designate at start of day which score will be used in the "pair" ride.

We will use the score from the first class and the score from the Jumper pair class to determine a winner! Fast & clean wins!

Champions and Reserve Champions

At each show, a Division Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded to the rider/horse with the most points in that division. Ties will be decided by the highest placing over fences.

The Year End Champions and Reserve Champion awards will go to the riders/horses that have the highest points at all the shows in their respective Division. We will also have an award for the High Point Jumper Rider AND the High Point Eq/Hunter Rider who has earned the most points throughout the year.

Point System:

1st - 7 points, **2nd** - 5 points, **3rd** - 4 points, **4th** - 3 points, **5th** - 2 points, **6th** - 1 point

Division Champion - 10 Points

Division Reserve Champion - 5 points

Our Championship Horse show is the last show of the season. In order to qualify to ride at this show you will need to have ridden in at least one Tri-Valley Classic Show during the current season.

Riders/Horses at this final show will earn DOUBLE POINTS! We will be presenting our year end awards at the end of each division throughout the Championship Show day!
